# Toph the Resilient Cat

Toph and his littermates arrived at AHS from a high-kill shelter in Illinois at 8 weeks old. Toph had severe eye infections, and his left eye was unusually small. After treatment with antibiotic drops and a visit to an ophthalmologist, it was found that Toph had no functional vision but could perceive light in his right eye. Despite efforts to save it, Toph eventually lost light perception, and both eyes were removed to ensure his comfort. Now fully recovered, Toph is a sweet, resilient kitten. His eye care totaled \$2,500. Can you help?

# From Uncertainty to Hope

On August 15th, our partner, Animal Rescue Corps, responded to a puppy mill closure in Oklahoma, rescuing 67 dogs, including English Bulldogs, Bichons, Shih Tzus, Papillons, and more. Puppy mills are breeding operations that prioritize profit over animal welfare, resulting in severe neglect and untreated health issues for the dogs.

Animal House Shelter has taken in over 30 of these dogs, all of whom share a common thread of uncertainty. Though they clearly yearn for contact and affection, their hesitation and confusion highlight the effects of their previous lives of isolation and neglect. They are slowly adjusting, receiving the medical care they need, and getting ready to find the loving homes they truly deserve.

Among them are dogs facing serious health challenges, such as mammary tumors, vaginal hyperplasia, hernias, dental issues, and pregnancy. Your donations are essential to provide the ongoing medical care they need and support their journey to recovery and adoption.

# **Cupid's Miraculous Recovery**



Cupid arrived at AHS with his mom and eight siblings when he was just 4 weeks old. At 2 months old, he was diagnosed with an intrahepatic portosystemic shunt, a condition that impairs liver function. He was sent home with medication to manage ammonia levels and prevent seizures, along with a special diet designed to support liver health. The plan was to wait

until he was 8 months old and adequately grown to undergo surgery that would significantly extend his lifespan. Without this surgery, Cupid would face liver failure and likely have a maximum lifespan of just 2 years.

Cupid has undergone surgery to place a stent and coils designed to improve blood flow through his liver and enhance its function. Over the next few months, he is expected to gain weight, experience increased energy, improve muscle development, and enjoy a longer, healthier life. Cupid's surgery will total approximately \$7,800.
